The transplantation of bile ducts from rats in the neck of other hosts is a good model for studying the immunological mechanisms of biliary rejection. We describe a procedure for bile duct transplantations in the neck of rats that has some of the advantages of other transplantations, without altering the biliary tract or the neck vasculature of recipients. In this type of transplantation, the duct epithelium, although transplanted, appears normal and differentiated, and appears to be protected from rejection. However, the complete reestablishment of a natural network of vessels that would permit the long-term viability of the graft is not achieved. The total rejection of the bile duct was observed in recipients, and could be prevented by pretransplant treatment with cyclosporine (Cy). The very rapid rejection of this type of graft is probably due to the absence of alloantigens and/or delayed induction of an immune response by a xenogeneic factor. The ability of the rat's peribiliary capillary system to preserve a high viability after transplantation is surprising, since it has been reported that such a system in other organs loses viability rapidly after transplantation.COLOMBO, Sri Lanka — Sri Lankan security forces have arrested a suspected Islamic State recruit on the island of Sicily, the country's Criminal Investigation Department said. Police said Saturday that the arrest Sunday morning in the small town of Decina, in the province of Messina, was the first in Sicily since Italy began taking in immigrants from Libya, where the Islamic State is based. "If this individual had not been arrested, he would have spread Daesh in Sicily and it would have been a grave threat for the security of all our cities," Mr. Greco told the Gazzetta di Sicilia, a prominent local newspaper, using the Arabic acronym for Islamic State.
